APPLICATION UPDATES

Ann Arbor State Bank - Brooke Lippo, AASB Representative and Mural Artist Joseph Macklin were present to discuss Ann Arbor State Banks mural slated for spring. Discussion of suggested recommended paints of either Behr, Kilz or Primer 1-2-3 be used as an undercoating to seal the bricks before applying mural paints and a clear coat of Graffiti seal. Anti Graffiti coat protects from graffiti for ease of clean up with also allows up to a 15 year maintenance.

- Glidden Mural Project – Burtch and Dobies
 - Gigliotti to talk Judy Horne at Ella Sharp Museum about curating the inaugural display.
- Louise Nevelson – Summer Night Tree – Meyer-Jackman and Pilgrim
 - Meyer-Jackman stated that the city cannot issue bid requests until half of the project costs are raised. Weatherwax needs a proposed budget before the foundation can approve funding which leaves the project in limbo. Chair Harrison conferred. Dobies stated that he would discuss with Burtch to see what can be done.

COMMISSIONER COMMENT

Chair Harrison stated that JPAC should consider a bus trip to the Toledo Museum to see their art glass collection. She challenged each commissioner to bring one idea to the February meeting of using glass art in the city.

Chair Harrison further stated that JPAC needs to be open to what is considered art. Qualifications of a selection committee needs to be clear as well as the process for selection of future pieces that the city implements/installs. We are all volunteers not employees and it's vastly important that we are involved with any project the city is involved in regarding use of art and these processes clearly understood.
