



SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

May 31, 2018

CALL TO ORDER:

The Jackson City Council met in special session in the City Hall and was called to order at 5:32 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

The Council joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Mayor Derek J. Dobies, Councilmembers Arlene Robinson, Freddie Dancy, Jeromy Alexander, Colleen Sullivan. Councilmember Craig Pappin arrived after roll call.

Absent: Councilmember Andrew Frounfelker.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA:

Motion was made by Councilmember Dancy, seconded by Councilmember Robinson to adopt the agenda. Votes - Yeas: Mayor Dobies, Councilmembers Robinson, Dancy, Alexander, and Sullivan (5). Nays: none. Absent: Councilmembers Pappin and Frounfelker (2).

CITIZEN COMMENTS:

Citizen comments were heard and the meeting continued.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Resolution - 2018-19 Annual City of Jackson Budget.

Recommendation: Approve a resolution adopting the fiscal year 2018-19 annual budget providing appropriations for various funds (except for the CDBG funds, which are adopted separately), amending the current fiscal year 2017-18 budget to those amounts projected, and ordering a tax levy.

Motion was made by Councilmember Sullivan, seconded by Councilmember Robinson to approve for discussion. After discussion concluded a vote was taken to approve the budget. Votes - Yeas: Mayor Dobies, Councilmembers Robinson, Dancy, Alexander, Pappin, and Sullivan (6). Nays: none. Absent: Councilmember Frounfelker. Motion carried.

No further business being offered, a motion to adjourn was made by Councilmember Pappin, seconded by Councilmember Robinson. Vote was done by voice with all in favor. Mayor Dobies adjourned the meeting at 6:00 p.m.
