Statement of Significance: The telephone industry came early to Jackson, growing tremendously by 1895, when this building was constructed. Initially the building was one-story, but three years later, with a total of 1,869 subscribers, the offices were expanded to include the second story. Michigan Bell Telephone Company occupied the building on W. Cortland Street until they erected a new building on S. Jackson in 1927. Beginning in the 1930s the building was the home of The Nieralumin Co., specializing in aluminum alloys. By the 1940s the building was the home of the Knights of Columbus (KofC). The KofC remained in the building over 40 years.

Statement of Significance: The first Masonic Lodge was formed in Jackson County in 1838, but it wasn't until the opening years of the twentieth century that the growing number of Masons in Jackson could not be accommodated in their rented quarters. In 1903 the Masonic Temple Association was formed for the express purpose of erecting anew building. The task before the association board was substantial, requiring an estimated \$47,998.00 to carry out architect Claire Allen's design. Finally, in 1907, the cornerstone was placed for the new Masonic Temple on Cortland Street. The temple served as the meeting and gathering place for the Masons and Jackson community through the 1980s. A portion of the building was leased to neighboring Vermeulen's Furniture Store in the 1960s, and the firm ultimately purchased the entire building in the late 1980s.

Statement of Significance: Peter L. Fox, for whom the building was named, was a blacksmith and carriage maker who had his shop at the corner of Francis and Washington in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. While the original date of construction is unclear, by 1918, local city directories include the first clear reference to the building, listing the occupants of the "Fox Block" as White Sewing Machine Company and the LaRue Printing Company. Both the sewing machine sales office and the commercial printer called the building home into the 1930s. In fact, LaRue Printing continued to occupy a large portion of the building into the 1980s while the storefront at 222 seems to have changed tenants at least every decade.

Statement of Significance: The building at 236 Francis/130 E. Washington was originally constructed as two separate structures and businesses. The structure at 236 Francis, the later of the two structures, was constructed on the site of the P. L. Fox Carriage Factory. The Jackson City Directory reveals that the location was vacant in 1927, and the location of the Barlow Service Station in 1928. The new service station was owned by Arlo and Martin Barlow, with Edna Barlow serving as bookkeeper. The station continued to operate at the site until the mid-1930s, when the former manager, Bernard (Bud) Louis purchased the business and renamed it Louis 24 House Service. The service station, and its expanded services which occupied the building at 130 E. Washington, continued to operate through most of the twentieth century.

The company was established in 1881, with their production facilities situated in several small buildings along N. Jackson by 1886. By 1893 the entire southern portion of the building complex was in place, although several dwellings continued to occupy the northern portion of the property along Calhoun Street. It was not until the first decades of the twentieth century was the expanded to its current configuration, occupying the entire block north of the railroad right-of-way to Calhoun between N. Jackson and Inham streets. In 1895, George D. Walcott and Son was described as a manufacturer of machine tools, making seven different sizes of shaping machines, and six different sized of lathes. Thirty years later, Walcott Machine Co was lauded as the manufacturers of the tools behind the automobile industry.

Statement of Significance: In 1885 the Eldred Mill was constructed by owners George T. Smith and Zenas C. Eldred at the advantageous site near the shore of the Grand River. The building was situated on a spur from the Michigan Central Railroad crossing the north side of the property and immediately east of the Geo. T. Smith Middlings Purifier Co. Works. The mill was designed by Mr. N. W. Holt, an employee of the Smith Middlings Purifier Co., which specialized in assisting customers in erecting or remodeling mills. The mill facility was completed in 1888 with the construction of a separate building to house the engineering portion of the facility immediately west of the original structure. Today, this small structure, although no longer boasting its smokestack, is the only extant portion of the facility. The highly regarded Eldred Mill produced high quality flour into the 1920s (under the name of Heywood Milling in its final years). By 1929 the small building was divided between the Heywood Milling Co., and Jack's Auto Laundry. Essentially an elaborate car wash, the laundry offered auto washing, greasing, lubricating, steaming, and permanizing. Eventually the entire building was given over to the auto servicing industry before being purchased in the mid-1940s to serve as a warehouse for nearby Howard's Feed Store.

Statement of Significance: Records pertaining to the building ownership prior to 1917 were not available, but based on several maps and the architectural style of the building it appears to have been constructed between 1863 and 1881. The first known occupants include the grocery store of Pierce & Cooper at street level, with Mrs. Belle Van Court providing furnished rooms in the upper level of the building. Mrs. Van Court continued to rent furnished rooms through the 1920s, but the ownership of the street level grocery store changed frequently in the 1910s and 1920s. The building housed Stuart's Fish Grill in 1932 and the Blossom Cafe in 1933, but is noted in directories as vacant in 1934 and 1935. The vacancy is probably incorrectly reported based on information from Mr. Vince Genco, son of the original shoe repair shop owners. Mr. Genco believes his father opened his shoe repair store in 1934 at the site. The third generation of the family continues to operate the repair shop, along with a full shoe store, in the building today.

Statement of Significance: The first known reference to a business in the building at the southwest corner of N. Mechanic and W. Pearl occurred in 1870, when C. B. Simmons placed an advertisement in the Jackson Daily Citizen. Simmons was announcing his successorship to the business of M. Collamer, and the opening of Coffin Rooms in connection with Furniture "at the old stand." In 1886, the first published Sanborn map of the area indicated the large building, divided into six storefronts. The drawing indicated that the building tenants included a grocery store, two saloons, a tea shop, music business, and furniture store. Upper floors of the three-story building were dedicated to either apartments for business owners or furnished rooms. For a time, the building also included the Central Hotel. Among the most notable of building tenants was E. C. Greene, a long-time clothier in Jackson occupied the northeast corner storefront from 1913 through the 1930s.

In spite of its standing in the community, the firm occupied rented rooms in large commercial buildings on Michigan Avenue until the construction of its building on S. Mechanic. Statement of Significance: The earliest known written reference to the store occurred in December 1871, when N. G. Davis advertised his grocery store at 233 and 235 Mechanic Street. The fact that the building and the advertisement refer to the same building came several years later when the building was illustrated in the 1874 Jackson County map. Davis continued to operate the grocery until 1876 when he became the proprietor of the Davis Exchange. With the departure of the grocery business, the location was then rented by Charles C. Bloomfield. Bloomfield's business, Bloomfield and Co., was his first company in what would be a long and hugely successful career. The firm was renamed Bloomfield Oil Company in 1887, and absorbed by Standard Oil in 1889. Bloomfield went on to be one of the major business leaders in the community, serving as the president of the Coronet Corset Company and Standard Gig Saddle Co. He also served as vice-president and later president of the Union Bank. The welfare of the city was also important to Bloomfield, who served on the city's hospital board beginning with its organization in 1889 and constructed the building that would be the last home of the public library before its own building was erected in 1907. After Bloomfield Oil closed in 1889, the building served as home to a variety of businesses, including several grocery stores, the M&M Corset Company, later M&K Corset, and Cowley's Cut Rate Shoes.

Statement of Significance: Constructed in 1893, the Bloomfield Building was erected by Jackson businessman Charles C. Bloomfield. Bloomfield began his career as a clerk in the crockery store of Bliss & Ingalls. After five years he bought out the branch of the store that sold kerosene oil, moving his new business to the building at 201 S. Mechanic. Initially known as Bloomfield & Company, the firm was renamed Bloomfield Oil Company in 1887 and absorbed by Standard Oil in 1889. After the sale of his business, Bloomfield served as president of Coronet Corset Co and Standard Gig Saddle Co, and as vice-president and later president of the Union Bank. Concerned with the welfare of the community, Bloomfield served ten years on the city's hospital board beginning with its organization in 1889. The building which bears his name was erected in part to serve as the location of the public library. The location was the final site of the public library prior to the construction of its permanent home as a result of funding by the Carnegie Foundation in 1907. As well as housing the public library, the building served as the entrance and lobby of the Anthaneum Theatre housed in a separate building west of the Bloomfield Building. The large Bloomfield Building also served as the permanent home of the Jackson Business University from 1928 into the 1990s.

Statement of Significance: The People's National Bank was founded in 1865 and by 1885 was the only national bank operating in the City of Jackson. The bank was historically located at the southeast corner of E. Michigan and S. Mechanic, but the present building is at least the second constructed by the bank at the site. The current building was erected between 1912 and 1917, when the city directory noted that there were eight floors associated with the building. Among the building tenants in 1917 were lawyers, real estate agents, insurance salesmen, physicians, and dentists. While the building continued to bear the name of the bank, in 1929 the bank merged with the National Union Bank to form the Union and Peoples National Bank. This new bank quickly embarked on the construction of a new banking house, the seventeen story building designed by architect Albert Kahn located at 120 W. Michigan.

Statement of Significance: The exact date of construction for the E. Michigan Avenue building is unknown, but based on similarity of architectural features with several other buildings in Jackson with known construction dates, it appears the building was erected ca. 1870. The first indication of the building's occupant does not occur until 1886, with the building labeled "hand printing" on the published city map. By 1890 city directories indicate the building was the location of Bernard Grunauer's shop, which both manufactured and sold millinery goods. At the same time, the third floor of the building served as the local YMCA Hall. By 1904, Moses L and William Jacobson purchased what was then known as the Faulkner-Porter store, and converted the space into the first Jackson location of the Jacobson's store. Jacobson's occupied the building until 1918 when they constructed the Ester Jacobson Building at 113 W. Michigan. Over the following years, the building was occupied by restaurants, a hosiery store, drug store, a branch of the Michigan Bank-Midwest, and an appliance shop. Most recently the building served as the Administration Offices of the Jackson Public Schools, but is currently vacant.

The building was the home of Glasgow Bros. & Dack, later simply Glasgow Bros.. Glasgow Bros was established in 1884, and was noted for "selling good goods cheap." In 1898 the original firm dissolved, with Dack going on to become a major producer of undergarments in the city. The firm began with just five clerks in 1884, and had grown to employ 90 clerks and maintenance workers by 1937 when it claimed full department store status. Glasgow Brothers anchored the eastern portion of the building into the 1960s. By 1964, the company had gone out of business and their former location for slated for demolition, when Furman's Inc., a men's clothing store, announced plans to begin removal of the former Glasgow Bros building by the end of the year. In addition to the major tenancy of Glasgow Bros., the building was the location of numerous smaller apparel and millinery shops over the years.

Statement of Significance: The building boasts a nameplate rising above the cornice, with the inscription: N. S. Potter 1921. In 1921, N. S. Potter (Nathan S.), was the president of the Jackson City Bank, the Michigan Bag and Paper Company, and automobile body manufacturing firm known as The Body Company. In spite of his association with the automobile, Potter does not appear to have any closer ties to the building or its tenants that ownership of the structure. The first business to occupy the site was the Motor Sales Corp., who held the space just two years before Truxell Sales Co occupied the space in 1924. Truxell Sales Co., owned by Mr. Grover O. Truxell of Lansing, Michigan, was noted for their sale of Durant and Star Automobiles. Beginning in 1925 the building was the location of the Sprague Auto Supply and Garage. Numerous other firms, all with a links to the automobile industry or to transportation occupied the building into the 1940s. Since 1949 the building has been the home to a single business, Holda's Appliance and Television, which advertises itself as "Jackson's Oldest Appliance Dealer."

Statement of Significance: In 1925 work began to develop what was considered at the time the most elaborate and largest hotel project ever undertaken in Jackson. As a result of the work undertaken by the Community Operating Company and the Jackson Community Hotel Co, capital of \$900,000 was raised and the 203 room hotel erected. On November 29, 1926 that the Hayes Hotel opened its doors for inspection by stockholders and their families. Among those touring the new facility was Mr. Clarence B. Hayes, president of Hayes Wheel Company, for whom the hotel was named. The elaborate hotel boasted a bathroom with each guestroom and several special suites and sample rooms. Public rooms included a lounge, lobby, main dining room, kitchen, and office on the first floor. The ground floor included the coffee shop, barber shop, general services, and utility departments. Constructed of reinforced concrete resting on heavy piers sunk deep into the earth, newspaper articles often noted the fireproof construction of the Georgian Revival style building. Forty years after they opened the Hayes Hotel underwent modernization and was rechristened the Hayes Motor Hotel. Since its time as a major local hotel, the building was occupied for a number of years by Consumers Energy, and is currently vacant.

Statement of Significance: The Detroit, Jackson & Chicago Railway was incorporated on January 12, 1907 under one of the street railway acts passed by the State of Michigan with an operating capital of \$25,000. Operating in Jackson, Washtenaw, and Wayne counties, the firm was controlled by the Detroit United Railway at the time of its incorporation. The exact date of construction of the small building is unclear. In 1907, published maps of the city indicate the structure located at the site of the car barn was a dwelling. A specific reference to the building does not appear in published city directories until 1917, although the utilitarian nature of the structure may have been the reason for this since public structures associated with the street railroad were listed much earlier. The car barn served the interurban railroad until 1929, when after several years of fighting to save the interurban line, the operations ended on September 4, 1929. Ironically, the year after the buildings association with the street railroad ended, it became a branch of L. A. Wright Motor Sales. From 1930 through the present day, the building has retained its association with the automobile industry, serving as the home of several dealerships and more recently a repair shop.

Statement of Significance: Erected in 1873-74, the building was once part of the three-story building originally known as the Mosher Academy of Music. Building owner, Jackson mayor Benjamin Mosher, hired L. D. Grosvenor to draw the plans for what he called one of the finest "blocks" in the city. The building included two storefronts at street level with the "spacious hall for balls, meetings, etc, above." The exterior of the building was described as featuring a full Frear stone (an early cast stone product) front of "tasty design." As expected, the new opera house provided the citizens of Jackson a wide variety of entertainment. While the primary use of the Mosher Block was for the auditorium space, several other major tenants also occupied the building. The first was S. M. Isbell & Co., seed distributor and dealer in beans and farm products. Isbell was established in 1878 and utilized the Pearl street location as both offices and warehouses before a new warehouse was constructed off N. Mechanic. By offering high quality product, the company gained a world-wide reputation for the celebrated Isbell Brand of hand-picked beans. For a time, the W. Pearl location was also shared by the Coronet Corset Manufactory. Founded in 1880, the company was based on the Cornet corset invented by firm partner Mrs. C. A. McGee. The firm was unusual for its female president and director, who managed their 10 to 12 employees during their first year of production. Eventually the firm became one of the major corset manufacturers in Jackson.

Statement of Significance: The building at 154-156 W. Pearl was constructed ca. 1920. In 1921, the local city directory indicates the building had the dual purposes of "Auto Inn" and "Jackson Auto Laundry." The following year, the ownership of the building is attributed to Michigan Buick Sales Company. An area map produced in 1930 indicates the building as "Garage Capcy: 80 cars." At the time, this building is one of four such buildings on the block defined by W. Pearl, Clinton (Louis Glick), N. Jackson, and N. Mechanic. Today the W. Pearl location is the only extant former garage. Under the ownership of Rayner Field, president, and L. C. Watkins, secretary-treasurer, the building housed a dealership for Buick products. It is unclear if the Auto Inn was also owned by Field and Watkins, but as "Buick Storage" it seems a natural conclusion to make. The firm held the location for over a decade, but by the end of the 1930s, the automotive distributor was Field Pontiac. Over time, the building was the sales location for Buick, Pontiac, Cadillac, and Nash automobiles. Since 1978 the building has been the home of Collins Bros Flooring.

Statement of Significance: Based on information from published maps and city directories, it appears the building at 159-161 W. Pearl was constructed ca. 1920. The first known occupant of the building was the Central City Paint Company. By 1924 the building was shared by the Quickedge Sharpener Co., who made grinding machines, Kellogg Corset Co., and Northern Coca Cola Bottling Co. The arrival of the Kellogg Corset Company marked the start of a tenancy that would continue for over 60 years. Initially the corset manufacturer shared the building with the other firms, but by 1932, they were the sole occupants. Founded by Douglas C. Kellogg and John Mark in 1909, the company was originally known as M and K Corset Co., and the 16th corset company located in the City of Jackson. By 1916 the original ownership partnership had been dissolved, and the firm renamed to Kellogg Corset. In spite of the fierce competition faced by the corset company, they were able to establish a nationwide customer base, eventually moving into orthopaedic appliances and braces. By 1971, only two corset companies survived in Jackson, including Kellogg Corset.

Early published fire insurance maps of the city include the notation "sal" or saloon for the building. Statement of Significance: Although little information is available on the building, it appears to have been constructed ca. 1850. This determination is based on the brick construction, segmental arched windows on the non-public faces of the structure, and simple hood ornaments on the front facade. The date is also substantiated by the presence of a simple rectangular building with the same characteristics as the present day structure on a map of Jackson prepared in 1853. The first indication of the building's use came in 1886, when the structure is labeled "Sal" or saloon on the Sanborn Map. Subsequent maps prepared in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century label the building as either vacant store or store. Clayton R. Hunt, is noted as the occupant of the building in 1917, although there is no indication of the building's use. The following year, in 1918, the two story building is the location of the Koffeman & Peyhas restaurant. The building remained a restaurant into the mid-1920s, but changed ownership at least once. Since 1925 the building has changed hands just three times. Both Adolph P. Koch, harness maker, and the Koch Typewriter & Supply Co occupied the building from 1925 to 1935. By 1939 the entire building was occupied by Koch Typewriter and Supply. Since the 1940s the building has been home to Jackson Key Works and the watch repair shop known as Precisin Instrument Service.
